



Roy L. Cordes, Sr.

November 26, 1921 - October 29, 2013

A memorial service for Roy Leon Cordes, Sr., 91, of Sugar Land, Texas will be held at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, November 2, 2013 at First United Methodist Church, 431 Eldridge Road in Sugar Land, Texas.

Roy was born November 26, 1921 in Ellinger, Texas to Hugo Henry and Alma Meyer Cordes. During World War II, he served as a pilot in the U.S. Army Air Corp and received decorations for his service in the CBI and Berlin Airlift. He later went on to retire as Lt. Colonel in the Air Force. Roy was known as a man who served God, his country and his community. He and his wife, Betty were long-time residents of Sugar Land and have seen the growth over the years. Roy was a business man, owning Cordes Cleaners, a washateria and a package store. During the 1960's Roy was elected to City Council and eventually became Mayor from 1972 until 1981. Roy passed away October 29, 2013 at his home in Sugar Land.

He is survived by his wife of 69 years, Betty Friend Cordes; son, Roy L. Cordes, Jr. and wife, Helen; sister-in-law, Beverly Wappler; special niece, Jill Wappler; along with step grandchildren, step great grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.
