Rudy's Catholic faith was strong. He started as an altar boy and later joined the Knights of Columbus. He also met his wife, Gloria, at Holy Family Catholic Church. It's where they were married and where his children received their sacraments. Rudy's life was a living example of his favorite Bible verse, Philippians 4:13 – "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

Rudy was somebody some might describe as stubborn, an adjective he was proud of. He was strict with his children but as soon as he became a grandfather, his stern voice was gone. Rudy enjoyed sitting on his patio, watering his flowers, picking his chiles and watching his grandson Dash play.

There was nowhere else he'd rather be. His contagious smile, strong personality and sense of humor will be missed by all who knew him.

Rudy is survived by his loving wife of nearly 37 years, Gloria and their four devoted children: Susan, Amanda (Anthony Gamez), Rudy III, and Rebecca.
