Russell William Thomas, fondly known as “Russ,” passed away on December 27, 2024, in Richmond, Texas. He was born on September 5, 1945, in San Diego, California to Homer Hubert Thomas and Billie Leona (Endress) Thomas.

Russ graduated from San Diego State University. He taught at Santa Barbara High School before moving to Houston in 1979. He was a contract manager for Binswanger Glass Company before returning to teaching at Elkins High School in Missouri City, Texas until his retirement in 2010.

Russ was a long-time parishioner of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Richmond, Texas. He taught RCIA, was a member of the Knights of Columbus and participated in many ACTS retreats over the years.
