After a lengthy illness, Santiago Lopez went to be with the Lord, on Friday, May 16, 2014. He was born on November 23, 1942, in Rio Grande City, TX. He was preceded in death, by his parents, Severiano Lopez, Sr. and Herminia Lopez; 2 brothers, Jose Saul Lopez and Severiano Lopez, Jr.

He is survived by his wife Esperanza Hope Lopez of 46 years and 2 daughters, Dina Barboza and her husband Daniel, and Beyda Denise Torres and her husband Leopoldo. Mr. Lopez, upon high school graduation, enlisted in the Air Force, where he served for a number of years. He graduated from Pan American University – UT in Edinburg, TX, with a Bachelor of Education Physical Education and Spanish. He received his Master of Science from Prairie View University in Prairie View, TX. He was a teacher/coach for McAllen ISD and Lamar CISD and was a Spanish teacher for Van Vleck ISD and Needville ISD.

He was the Owner of Twin City Dr. Ed. School in Richmond, TX from 2006 – 2013. Mr. Lopez attended Friendship Church A/G, where served as a Deacon from 2005 – 2008.

Funeral services will be at Davis-Greenlawn Chapel and Cemetery in Rosenberg, TX, where Rev. David G. Rose, Senior Pastor of Friendship Church A/G, will officiate. The family will receive family, friends, and guests on Monday, May 19, 2014, from 5:00pm to 8:00pm, with service at 7:00pm. The funeral/burial will be Tuesday, May 20, 2014, at 10:00am.

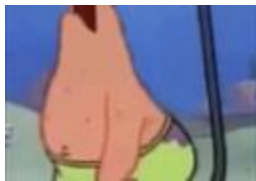
