Funeral services for Scott Orsak, 21, of Richmond, will be held at 10:00 A. M., Thursday, July 19, 2007 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg with Father Howard Drabek officiating. Interment will follow at a later date in Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.
