Shirley Jean Schwarting Stavinoha was born to Howard and Willie Mae Schwarting on December 2nd, 1930, in Jones Prairie, Texas and passed away June 5th, 2023. She grew up on the family farm just outside of Cameron Texas. At the age of 14, she and her parents moved to Rosenberg and she graduated from Rosenberg High School in 1948.

She met Teddy Stavinoha after his return home from WWII. They married on September 5th, 1949 at Holy Rosary Catholic Church. They celebrated 49 years of marriage until Teddy's death in 1998. 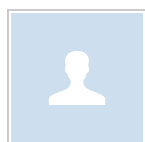

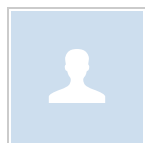
