



Silvian Sidney Kovar

August 10, 1944 - November 21, 2023

Silvian Sidney Kovar, 79 of Richmond, Texas, passed away Tuesday, November 21, 2023, in Houston. He was born August 10, 1944, in West Columbia to Joe James Kovar Sr. and Henrietta Bartosh Kovar. Silvian was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Richmond. Silvian graduated from Needville High School in 1962 and attended Wharton County Junior College. Silvian proudly served in Vietnam, during the Vietnam War, as a member of the United States Army and received an Honorable Discharge at the conclusion of his military campaign. After his military service, Silvian was hired by the WKM Foundry/ Cooper industries and worked there for 42 years until he retired in 2009.

Survivors include his wife of 53 years, LaVerne Freudensprung Kovar; 3 children, Kevin Kovar, Christie Kovar and life companion Daryl Peel, Jeff Kovar and wife Linda; brother, Joe Kovar Jr. and wife Bonnie; 3 sisters, Patricia Schimara, Vickie Eixmann and husband John Allen, Joyce Wendel and husband Alan; 5 grandchildren, Waylon Kovar, Nash Kovar, Liliana Kovar, Karina Kovar and John Cruz, along with a host of other loving family members and friends, especially his friends from the Needville Pub and his friends from his Monday domino game. He was preceded in death by his parents.

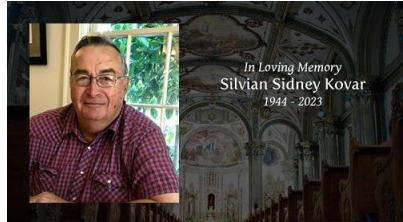

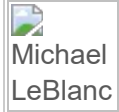
