January 1, 1932 - December 17, 2024

Stella Ramirez Shaw, 92, passed away peacefully on December 17, 2024. A talented artist and beloved mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, Stella touched countless lives through her warmth, creativity, and dedication to her family. Born to Margarito Ramirez and Filomena Tejada Ramirez, Stella built a remarkable career as a hairstylist, training in both Austin and New York City – an achievement she was particularly proud of. She went on to work at the prestigious Sakowitz in downtown Houston before owning and operating multiple beauty salons. Her exceptional skill and warm personality drew many notable clients, including First Lady “Lady Bird” Johnson and numerous actresses who performed at the Sheraton Hilton Hotel in Houston.

Known for her style and grace, Stella was rarely seen without her signature lipstick and heels, which she proudly wore throughout her working career. She had a playful spirit, often batting her eyelashes to make a point, and her infectious charm left an impression on everyone she met. Strong and feisty, yet kind and loving, Stella lived her life with conviction and compassion. Her deep faith was central to her life, and she often expressed that "she had a friend, and her friend was Jesus."

Beyond her professional achievements, Stella was known for her love of music, often bringing joy to others through her guitar playing and beautiful renditions of hymns and Mexican folk songs. Her musical talent and cultural heritage were integral parts of her identity that she lovingly shared with family and friends. She had a special place in her heart for cats, often opening her

home to strays and caring for them with the same devotion she showed to all living creatures, even the possum who once ate dinner inside with her cats. Stella was preceded in death by her husband, Wayne Shaw; Roland Keith Fueller, the father of her daughters; her parents; brothers Roy and Daniel Ramirez; and sister Lucy Oehler. She is survived by her sisters Jayne Johnson and Margaret Rehem; her daughters Deborah Taylor (widow of Paul), Audrey Fueller Bialas (David), and Valarie Atwood (Marc); step-daughter Whitney Long; grandchildren Wright Schwarting Jr., Tres Taylor, Lauren Hennes, Emily Holt, Stewart Atwood, and Garrett Atwood; step-grandchildren Raiden, William, and Amber; great-grandchildren Bailey, Lilah, Theodore, Carrigan, Lochlan, Crosby, and Miles; and step-great-grandchildren Tinsley and Reed.
