Suzette Russell (Braun), 68, of Richmond, Texas, passed away on April 22, 2026. She was born on January 6, 1958, in New Brighton, Pennsylvania, to her parents, Paul John Braun and Joanne Irvin Braun.

Suzette dedicated over 25 years of her life to her profession as a registered nurse, where she compassionately cared for patients, including newborns in the neonatal ICU.
