Suzy Carol (Curry) Scopel, 71, of Rosenberg, Texas passed away on October 26, 2018 with her family by her side. Born in Lubbock, she was the daughter of the late Dewey “Pete” Curry & Elnora (Dulaney) Curry of Tahoka. Suzy was raised in Tahoka where she graduated high school. She attended Texas Women’s University and graduated from West Texas A&M University with a bachelor’s degree in Education. She met the love of her life, Allen, and they enjoyed 42 blessed years of marriage. She was a beloved teacher working for 10 years in Plains, 2 years in Graham, and 20 years at Holy Rosary Catholic School in Rosenberg. Suzy was a long-time member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church where she faithfully served her church in various roles as a kitchen co-chair for the bazaar, Eucharistic Minister, Lector, and assisting with student masses. She further volunteered her time distributing beverages and snacks to firefighters for over 20 years in Rosenberg as a member of the Ladies Auxiliary. She was also involved with various committees for the Texas Fireman’s Auxiliary. She had a heart for helping others whenever possible and never met a stranger.
