



Theresa Ann (Novak) Todd

Theresa Ann Novak Todd, 84, passed away peacefully on Saturday, June 30, 2018. She was the fifth of 16 children, born in Fayetteville, TX, on July 25, 1933 to the late John W. and Julia (Chovanec) Novak. She was a member of St. George Catholic Church in Baton Rouge, LA.
