Thomas B. Atkins, 76, of Rosenberg, Texas, passed away on November 18, 2019 in Richmond, Texas. Tom was born on July 31, 1943 in Columbia, South Carolina to Blaine and Catherine McKinley Atkins. He was a member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church where he taught CCE for over 30 years and assisted with Bible School in the summer. He was also a member of the Knights of Columbus. He honorably served our country as a U.S. Marine from 1960 – 1969 during Vietnam. He was a past Commander for VFW Post #3903, and was a member of the American Legion Post #271 and the D.A.V. Tom was also a member of the Hermann Sons Life Organization. Tom had a deep rooted love for his family, faith and his country. This loving husband, father, stepfather, grandfather and friend will be missed.
