Timothy "Tim" Lewis Brewer, 63, of Rosenberg, Texas, passed away on April 21, 2026, in Sugar Land. He was born on May 16, 1962, in Sugar Land to John Elliott Brewer and Vivian Lea (Muehr) Brewer.

Tim was a graduate of Lamar High School, class of 1980, and a proud member of the Mighty Mustang Band, where he played tuba. He was a member of the Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg and the Knights of Columbus, Council No. 2801. He volunteered at many Holy Rosary Church Bazaars, popping popcorn and selling pickles. Tim was a Life Member of the Fort Bend County Fair and volunteered on various committees throughout his life. He enjoyed making the 40 gallons of barbecue sauce for Fairchild Volunteer Fire Department Annual BBQ Benefit. Tim was a frequent blood donor and in 2025, he achieved the 15 Gallon - Commit For Life Milestone. He worked at several places over the years including Price-Lo Grocery, Academy, Wessendorff Lumber Co., Home Lumber & Hardware Co., and the Texas Department of Transportation, where he ultimately retired after 20 hard-working years of service.

Tim met his wife, Donna, in high school band, and they were later married in August of 1984. They recently celebrated 41 years of marriage. They spent their time together traveling and making memories with their 3 children, Richard, Jenifer, and Keith.

Tim enjoyed being active at his children's events while they were growing up. All of them participated in the BF Terry High School Ranger Band Program where he became a dedicated Booster Member, even serving as President of the organization.

He watched his son Keith successfully rise through the ranks of Needville Troop 129, part of the Boy Scouts of America, where he ultimately earned his rank of Eagle Scout, the highest honor achievable through the organization.

Tim was elated to see Jenifer obtain her Master's Degree in Accounting from Sam Houston State University in Huntsville, a place very close to his heart where he spent many weekends visiting.

He enjoyed watching Richard farming out in the fields, driving tractors and riding along on the cotton picker any chance he could.

Tim and Donna loved traveling and seeing new places. His ultimate joys included the trips taken to Sip & Shop in Huntsville, family vacations to Galveston, Fredericksburg, and Luckenbach, and spending weekends at his sister Tammy's lake house in Seguin. Over the years, they traveled to Branson, Tennessee, Las Cruces, New Mexico, Washington, D.C., and most recently to Kentucky and Indiana, but his most memorable trip was a recent one to California where he got to accompany his son Keith, while he picked cotton.

Tim enjoyed the many weekends spent at deer camp, in Cat Springs, going after that big buck, fishing the lake on family property in Huntsville, and he really enjoyed getting together with the family every year to make homemade sausage.

After retiring, Tim could be found tinkering on little projects, canning anything that sounded good to can, and making homemade tamales! He looked forward to the weekly 'Old Farts Club' (the coffee club get together at his brother-in-law's), and attending baseball games, cheering on the Space Cowboys with Donna.

Tim is preceded in death by his parents, John & Vivian Brewer, his brother, John "Chris" Brewer, brother-in-law, Jody Poncik, father-in-law, Victor Poncik, and mother-in-law, Annie (Drabek) Poncik.
