Tom was a Life Member of the Texas PTA and Life Member of the Lake Dallas, TX VFW Post. He belonged to the American Legion, several country dance clubs, a local AARP chapter, and, at one time, belonged to Toastmasters.

Over the years he also volunteered in numerous other endeavors. We can't forget his love of cruises, casinos and playing poker.

Tom was very proud of his twenty-eight years in the US Air Force. He retired from the AF in 1984 as an E-8 (Senior Master Sergeant) at which time he began working for Boeing for ten years. His entire career was involved with flight simulators. While in the AF he earned many distinguished awards, medals and ribbons. He was stationed in Texas, California, Okinawa, the Philippines, Louisiana, Virginia and Oklahoma.

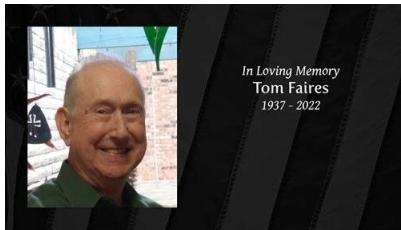
