



Victor John Macha

March 30, 1931 - August 16, 2019

Victor John Macha was born during the Depression on a small farm on March 30, 1931 in Wallis, Texas. His parents are John J. and Elsie (Fojtik) Macha. He is preceded in death by his parents and his only brother, Sylvester.

In 1951, Victor joined the National Guard and stayed until his retirement in 1991 as Chief Warrant Officer. Victor enjoyed his duties with the National Guard. He was in his forties when he went to jump school at Ft Benning, and quickly became a Jump Master. Skilled with small arms fire, he was on the Guards National Pistol team. He was stationed with Units in Rosenberg, Houston, Ellington Field, and finally at the Military Academy, Camp Mabry, Austin, TX. He once said, "our life belongs to others as much as it belongs to us, so we should not pursue an occupation solely for the love of money or fame, but because we thoroughly enjoy doing it for the love of God".

Victor married Juliana Wleczyk and had four children: Anthony Macha, Carmen Reno (Jimmy), Stephen Macha and Rita Macha. His grandchildren are Justin Macha, Jill Simpson (Geoff), Travis Reno (Amy), Shayne Macha (Tracy), Shelby Macha (Jordan), and Morgan Macha, and numerous nieces and nephews and cousins.

In 1981, Victor was the coordinator of the Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration Chapel at Holy Rosary Church in Rosenberg and a member of the Knights of

Columbus. Because of his strong love for the Blessed Sacrament, he spent many happy hours in that chapel each week.

In 1982, he began his trips, pilgrimages to many holy places throughout the world. His favorite and most visited was Garabandal Spain, a site of Marian Apparitions. His stories and photos about all of these Holy places made his listeners feel as though they were there.

Victor peacefully passed into eternity on August 16, 2019.

The family expresses sincere gratitude for the caring staff at Ft. Bend Health Care and Oak Bend Hospital. Their kindness and compassion meant a lot to Vic and the family.
