You're a very talented artist. You gave me a beautiful painting of a field with two mallards in the foreground. The canvas was a plow. Thank you, Vikki!

I remember giving you Christmas items from Bass Pro Shops. I think it was Christmas lights and a few Christmas tree ornaments. I was working there at the time, so I got a discount.

You're very sweet.

You also had a lot of hardships. There was drama from your divorce. He had purposely made it difficult for you and he abused the system by prolonging the court proceedings. He wouldn't give you money and tried to hide much of it.

You were tearful when your boxer unexpectedly passed. You told me that he was just laying there in the backyard. He wasn't old and in good shape. We don't know what really happened.

Now, you are in a beautiful place. I can see you painting on a canvas, in a green field of grass, mountains in the background and you are just smiling. I'm glad you are better now.

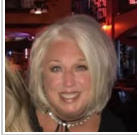
