Viola Stavinoha Hundl, 89 years young, of Rosenberg, Texas, lost her courageous battle with brain cancer Friday, Aug. 8, 2008.

Funeral services for Viola are 10 a.m. Tuesday, Aug. 12, 2008, at Holy Rosary Catholic Church with internment following at West Gethsemane Cemetery in Rosenberg on Highway 36 South. A reception follows at the Knights of Columbus Hall.
