Wilma Rodes, 86, of Spring, passed away Monday, April 7, 2008. She was born Feb. 24, 1922, in Llano, to the late Everette and Belle Martin. She graduated from Llano High School and received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Stephen F. Austin State University and a Master of Arts degree in English from the University of Houston.

Mrs. Rodes was a retired public schools teacher from Palacios ISD and taught at St. Philip's Catholic School in El Campo upon retirement.
