



Winston Wayne Loehr

April 26, 1938 - January 7, 2019

Winston Wayne Loehr, 80, passed away Monday, January 7, 2019 in Richmond. He was born April 26, 1938 in Peters Community in Austin County, to John Christoph Loehr and Leona Marie Hintz Loehr. Winston was confirmed in the Lutheran faith, Missouri Synod and received his Bachelor's Degree in education from A&M College of Texas in 1960. He taught school in Lake Jackson after graduation and then moved his family to Needville where he taught Junior High Mathematics from 1964 until his retirement in 1996. He was a school bus driver for both school districts. He was a talented woodworker and loved gardening. Winston built the largest 100 unit Purple Martin house in Fort Bend County and spent countless hours watching the birds come and go.

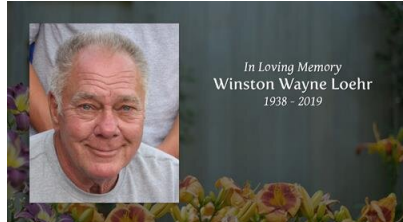
