After dated for about 6 months, Yick-Man and Chuen Yau were married and thus their beautiful history together began.

He had a wealth of knowledge but never stopped questing to discover what is happening or trending around the world and more.

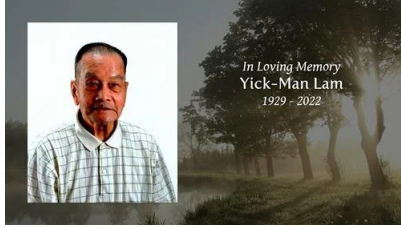
